Sagawa Art Museum

This scenic museum overlooking Lake Biwa offers permanent displays of works by Japanese painter Hirayama Ikuo, sculptor Sato Churyo, and many other artists. The teahouse, which appears to float within awater garden, is also a popular spot for visitors. (About a 5-minute drive from the hotel)

Ukimido

The famous Ukimido (floating temple) is known as the site of wild geese returning home at Katata, one of the classic 'Eight Views of Omi.' The temple, which appears to float on the lake, and the ever-changing sky reflected upon the waters of Lake Biwa are must-sees. (About a 15-minute drive from the hotel)
